



HOW TO WATCH A SUNDAY MORNING SERVICE ON YOUR TV

Below are ways and instructions on how to stream the services onto your TV. Please note some may vary or not work properly depending on what you use and your internet speed. For the best experience, we suggest using a smartphone, tablet, or computer in order to be able to use the chat, notes, and prayer request features of gsLIVE.

Streaming Devices (Apple TV, Roku, Amazon Fire, etc.)

The easiest way to stream our services using these devices would be to do it through the VIMEO app (you may have to download this app if you have not downloaded before). Once you download the vimeo app (you may have to create an account), but you can search for gracespring Bible Church and find our videos on there. You should see a "gsLIVE" video and when the event is schedule to go live. You can click that video and wait for us to go LIVE. In addition, if you have an Apple TV and an iPhone, you can simply go to the video through our church app or on safari and cast the video to your TV. This applies to macbooks and other apple devices if you have an Apple TV connected to our actual TV.

Laptop/Computer, Chromecast, or Smart TV

If you go to gsLIVE feed on your computer, you can cast it to your TV if your TV has a Chromecast connect or built in. If you do not have a Chromecast but have a HDMI cord, you can simply plug an HDMI cord into your computer and plug it into your TV and treat the TV as another monitor. If you have a smart TV, the VIMEO app might already be on the TV to use so you can follow the instructions above under streaming devices. You can also use the web browser on the TV and just simply type in the URL for our gsLIVE stream. We do not recommend this because some time the TV interface can be clunky when using their browser, but you are welcome to try!

Again, we think going through our gracespring church app OR directly using a web browser on a computer, smartphone, or tablet is best! Once again, this is the link(s) to use:
